The Cottage Museum is located in beautiful, historic Island Heights at 105 Simpson Avenue. It is owned and operated by the Island Heights Cultural & Heritage Association & is a short walk from the town's boardwalk along the Toms River. It is an 1880's style Carpenter Gothic two-story summer cottage that is open to the public & free of charge. It is open on **Saturdays, from 1:00 - 4:00 pm, from April through December**, or by request. We are children friendly and welcome small groups for private tours with 24-48 hour notice. Our display cases change throughout the year. A docent is there to guide you through this Victorian era cottage and/or answer your questions.
