ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ISLAND HEIGHTS, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE 2000-02 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ISLAND HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR AND REPACEMENT OF THE BULKHEAD AT THE WANAMAKER AND SUMMIT AVE. BEACH PROPERTIES, THE CONSTRUCTION OF GAZABOS ON THE WANAMAKER PROPERTY, THE REGRADING AND LANDSCAPING OF BOTH PROPERTIES AND APROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$620,000.00 THEREFORE AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$590,000.00 IN GENERAL 8IMPROVEMENT BONDS TO FINANCE THE SAME" TO FURTHER AMEND THE PURPOSES OF SAID ORDINANCE AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 2005-04

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Island Heights, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 3(a) of Ordinance 2000-02 as amended by Ordinance 2005-04 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The Projects hereby authorized and the purpose for financing of which the Bonds are to be issued is for the repair and replacement of various bulkhead structures and related improvements including, but not limited to, regrading and landscaping at various locations within the Borough of Island Heights".


Section 2. Section 6(d) of Ordinance 2000-02 is hereby amended to delete its reference to "\$60,000.00" and to insert in its place, "\$90,000.00."

Section 3. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part or parts thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
