

**AN ORDINANCE TO MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR  
MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF  
THE BOROUGH OF ISLAND HEIGHTS PURSUANT TO  
C. 52:14-15f et. seq.**

**ORDINANCE 2014 - 05**

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2013 c. 28 permits governing bodies to grant exemptions on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough of Island Heights, located in Ocean County, State of New Jersey according to the following:

- Section 1. All full time employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Borough of Island Heights are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of *July 1, 2014* in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under C.52:14-15f (b).
- Section 2. Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the Borough of Island Heights are exempt from the direct deposit mandate.
- Section 3. Municipal employees may request, in writing, an exemption from the direct deposit mandate to the Borough of Island Heights Payroll Clerk. Such requests will be presented to the Mayor & Council within one (1) month. The Mayor & Council may grant such an exemption by resolution and only for good cause.
- Section 4. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
