Public Comment

Margaret Gorman, CFO, stated she went through the ordinances to see what was done and not done. Since there was no other projects to be completed with regards to the ordinances, she went forward recommending them to be cancelled. Resolution 03-03 was for an ordinance for a new sewer main installation, fully funded by a General Improvement Bond in the amount of \$1,050, and 2008-10

was related to preliminary construction for water storage tank in the amount of \$4,621.27, also funded, and will go back into surplus. We will able to use that, take that into Capital surplus, if needed, and help the current budget. We also cancelled water sewer unfunded, which means we didn't go out for permanent financing. 06-06 was handicap and road improvements from Lake to River; 08-06 was for curbs, driving aprons and paving on chestnut avenue. The same that would've been issued in a General Improvement Bond. Now that we are canceling this, we don't have to raise that money. It's cleaning up our books, since it's good practice that Capital ordinances shouldn't be on the books more than five years. The CFO confirmed that will this reduce the bond anticipation note by the amount being cancelled.

Councilman Pillion stated that perhaps another Scout project is refurbishing the bulletin board at the Post Office.
