COUNCIL REPORTS

CP BERGLUND: The Borough Revaluation is approximately 80% and updates are being encoded. With regard to the Community Garden, some people didn't maintain their garden beds and were overgrown with weeds; until a young Boy Scout stepped in to provide weeding. Now, Noah Schaad is being recognized at his Eagle Scout Ceremony and invited Councilman Berglund to attend.

GABRIEL: The new County Radio System is moving forward. County agencies are using it as a test now for late 2019-early 2020. The Borough will need to budget for new radios after drop dead date.

THOMPSON: National observance at school will be way of a moment of silence tomorrow at 10am. The Grade School will have an art show; a Fair on the 22nd; and Board Meeting on 28th. Additionally, multiple street light reports have been addressed.

SNOW: Open Space grant was completed and applied to follow up for the designation of Certified Wildlife Habitat.

SILVER: The Ocean County Social Services has a Senior Volunteer Program from April 3-15th. Additionally, the Borough will recognize National Volunteer Week and the month of May as Older Americans Month.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

The Summit Avenue Beach does not have port-a-johns. Currently, there are no lifeguards and is “swim at your own risk”.

The Borough Clerk stated he will inquire with the Joint Insurance Fund as to whether this is a “dedicated” beach.

Seeing no other comments, Councilman Gabriel motioned to adjourn; Seconded by Councilwoman Snow, and full Council consent.
